There are two kinds of remembering. First, there is personal memory—and today it's especially vivid. I doubt there's an American over 35 who couldn't tell you exactly where they were and how they felt on September 11, 2001.

But there's another kind of memory too. And it may be the more important kind to reflect upon as we mark 25 years—a full generation—since that terrible day. When our forefathers exhorted us to "Remember the Alamo" or "Remember Pearl Harbor," they were talking about this second kind of memory. It wasn't just about recalling. It was about retelling: one generation passing on its stories and values to the next.

There's a collective sense among many of us that this isn't happening like it should. It's not just that younger Americans don't share the same visceral emotions about 9/11. It's that too many haven't grasped its lessons: about the reality of evil, the meaning of heroism—and the contrast between a worldview that produces hijackers and one that produces firefighters running up the stairs of the South Tower. Many of my generation have been complacent in pointing out that contrast to our children. We took it for granted that they'd adopt our love of God and country, without making a concerted effort to transmit it.

But if 9/11 showed us anything, it's that we can't take America for granted. Western liberty has enemies. And even the most ordinary of us, going about our daily lives, are called upon to defend it. So today, let's rekindle our memories, our patriotism, and our faith. Remember the fallen and honor the heroes who exemplified the American spirit to the end. And tomorrow, let's redouble our efforts to pass that spirit on to our children. May we never forget.



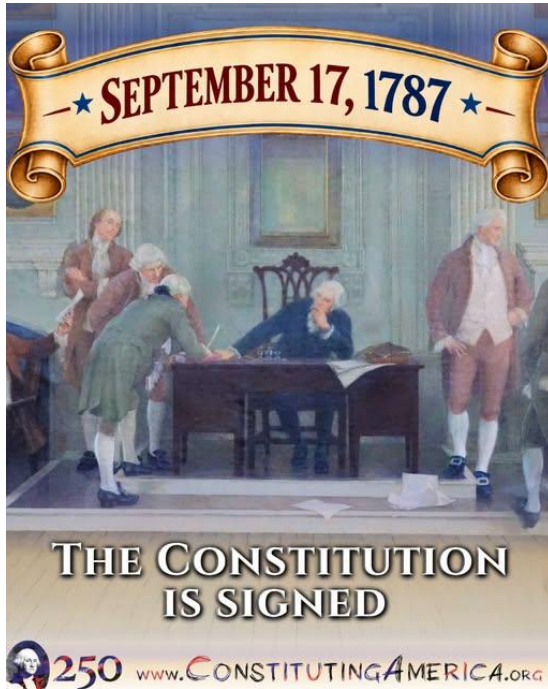
St. Paul's Chapel was 235 years old and stood less than 100 yards from the Twin Towers. When both towers fell, it lost not one pane of glass. A single sycamore in its yard took the debris. The next morning Rev. Lyndon Harris walked down Broadway expecting rubble and found a door he could open. For nine months it never closed. Firefighters slept in George Washington's pew. The burning pile melted workers' boots, so podiatrists treated their feet. Volunteers served 500,000 meals. "People were living what they believed." The pews are still scratched and nobody fixed them.

St. Paul's Chapel opened in 1766 on Broadway at Fulton Street and is the oldest surviving church building in Manhattan. George Washington prayed there on April 30, 1789, after taking the oath of office at Federal Hall a few blocks away. The chapel had already lived through the Great Fire of 1776. By September 2001 it was 235 years old and stood less than 100 yards from the World Trade Center. On September 11, 2001, both towers collapsed across the street. Dust and wreckage buried the churchyard. A large sycamore on the northwest corner of the property caught the falling debris. The building lost no glass, and the organ was the only serious damage. On September 12 the Rev. Lyndon Harris, a priest on the Trinity and St. Paul's staff, walked down Broadway expecting to find the chapel destroyed. Engineers inspected it and declared it sound.

Rescue workers came in first to wash up and rest between shifts on the pile. Harris ran the relief effort from the first week, and the chapel kept its doors open day and night for nine months. Volunteers worked twelve hour shifts serving meals, making beds, and sitting with firefighters, police officers, and construction workers, alongside podiatrists, chiropractors, massage therapists, and musicians. The pile was still burning and the heat melted workers' boots, so replacement boots became one of the most needed supplies. Exhausted workers slept in the pews, including Washington's, and their boots and equipment scratched the wood. Thousands of letters were taped to every surface, 13,000 of them from schoolchildren. Harris put the total at more than 15,000 volunteers and more than half a million meals, and parishioner Cindy Jay, who volunteered, said, "People were living what they believed." The relief ministry closed on June 2, 2002, after the Ground Zero cleanup ended. The scratched pews were never sanded down. Survivors of the Hiroshima and Nagasaki bombings sent thousands of folded paper cranes, and the city of London gave a Bell of Hope for the churchyard. In 2005 the chapel joined the Community of the Cross of Nails, a network founded by Coventry Cathedral after it was bombed in World War II.

The chapel now draws more than a million visitors a year. On September 11, 2026, the 25th anniversary, Trinity's rector rang the Bell of Hope at 8:46 a.m. and the parish read every victim's name. Through October 1, 2026, the "Ever Present" exhibition hangs 2,977 blue paper cranes above the nave, one for each person killed, folded by artist Talo Kawasaki with church members and passing tourists. The vestment covered in responders' patches and the children's letters hang beside them. Not one window broke, and for nine months not one door closed. 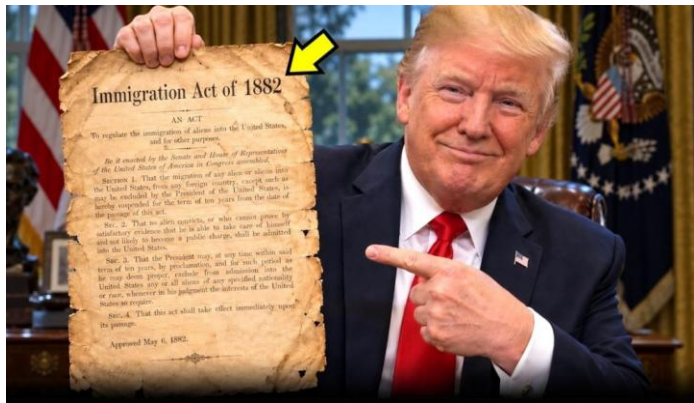

For decades the Pentagon let defense contractors charge American taxpayers twice. Pete Hegseth is ending it. "A broken Pentagon bureaucracy was doing the same thing for decades," Hegseth said. We've pushed out **the bureaucrats who made these deals in the past and replaced them with the most talented negotiators in the private sector, a group of businessmen so elite they've been rightly dubbed Deal Team Six.** It's simple. We're putting the American taxpayer first by offering you a better deal. We now move at the speed of business, not bureaucracy." The new rule is straightforward. Companies that want to expand production to sell more equipment to the U.S. military will pay for the factories, assembly lines, and plants themselves. In return they get steady, long-term orders for what the force actually needs. **Hegseth said the results are already showing: higher volume, faster delivery, and flat prices.** Companies that fail to deliver will be replaced. "Speed, volume, and fiscal responsibility—it's common sense, and it's what the American taxpayer demands." The War Department is moving from **bureaucracy** to business. **Over the coming weeks it will roll out more videos explaining how President Trump's \$1.5 trillion defense budget funds a generational investment in the arsenal of freedom. The money will secure the homeland and keep the U.S. military the most lethal fighting force on earth. "We're going to spend every dollar of that money responsibly," Hegseth said, "because that's what you deserve, that's what America needs, and that's what this President demands."**

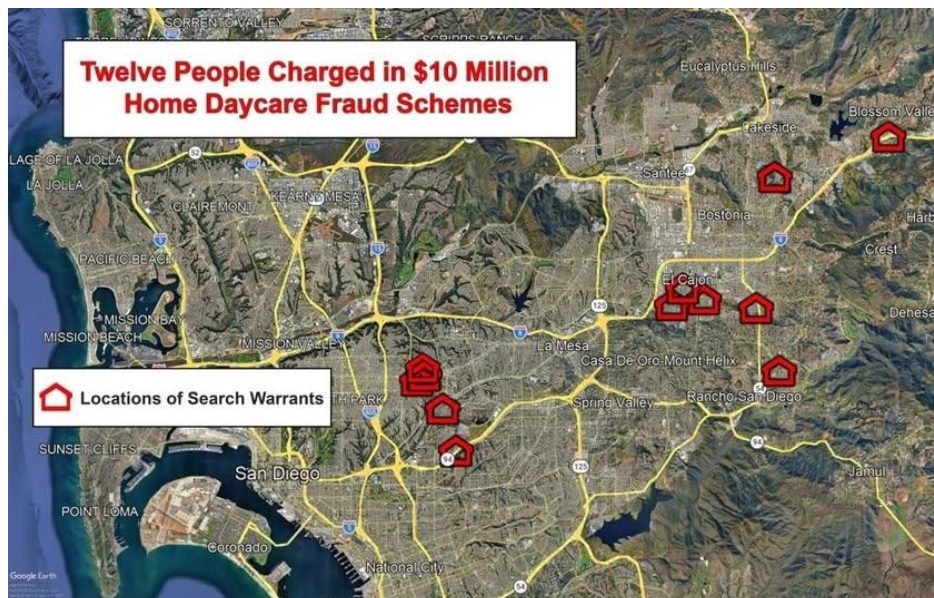

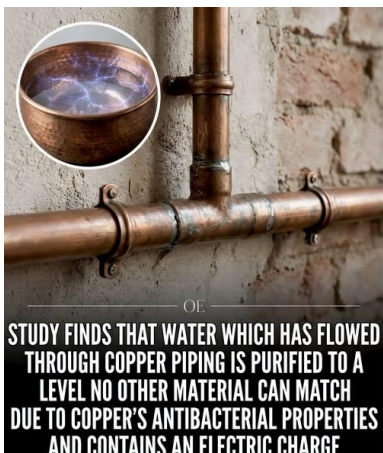

Eight U.S. states have now said no to lab-grown meat.

As of 2026, **Alabama, Florida, Indiana, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, Texas, and South Dakota** have passed laws banning or temporarily restricting cultivated meat. South Dakota became the eighth state, with its ban taking effect on July 1, 2026 and running through June 30, 2031. Supporters say the laws protect farmers, traditional agriculture, and food transparency. Critics argue they could limit innovation and consumer choice. Eight states have drawn the line. More could follow.

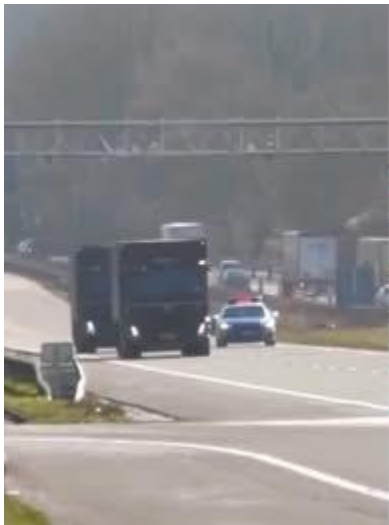

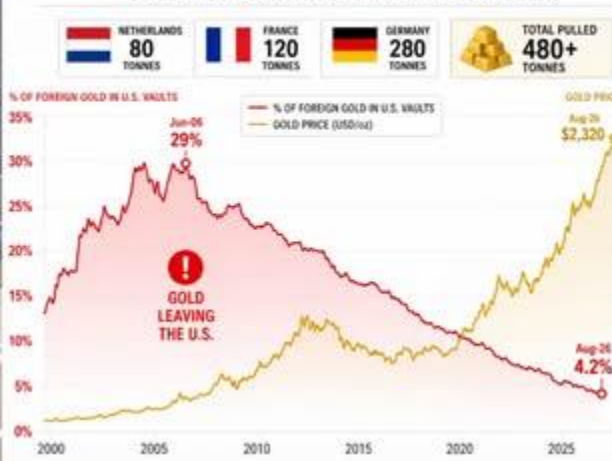
On February 15, 2026, three C-17 Globemaster cargo planes carried something across the United States that no aircraft had ever flown before: a working nuclear reactor. The mission, code-named **Operation Windlord**, was a joint effort between the Pentagon and the Department of Energy. The reactor at the heart of it is almost comically small for its job. Built by a California startup called Valar Atomics, the minivan-sized Ward 250 is made of eight modules, yet those eight can generate up to 5 megawatts of electricity, enough for roughly 5,000 homes.

The modules flew from an air base in California to Utah, where crews reassembled the reactor for testing. On June 18 it reached criticality, the point where its nuclear chain reaction becomes self-sustaining and the reactor is effectively switched on. **The milestone showed that compact nuclear power can be shipped in pieces and started up far from any traditional plant.**

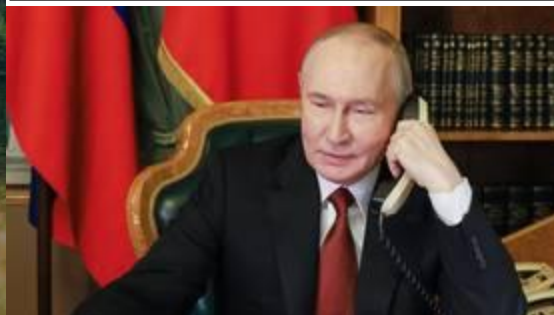

A black bear showed up at a wildlife center carrying an injured raccoon. Weeks later, the cameras caught something that left the staff speechless. Late one night, security cameras at a wildlife rehabilitation center in the United States captured the unusual visitor walking straight toward a back entrance. Instead of attacking the injured animal, the bear gently left it near the door and disappeared back into the woods. Staff found the raccoon alive and brought it inside for treatment. They assumed the encounter was nothing more than an incredibly strange coincidence.

Then, weeks later, it happened again. Another nighttime camera captured a black bear approaching the same facility, this time with an injured fox. That was when one employee noticed something unusual. Both recordings showed the same distinctive white patch on the bear's chest. Curious, the staff began checking old wildlife records and photographs from the area. What they discovered changed the entire story.

Years earlier, a young black bear with the same marking had been rescued and treated at that very center before being released back into the wild. No one could know exactly what the bear was thinking. But the possibility was difficult to ignore: after all those years, it may have remembered the place where humans once helped it and returned when other animals needed help. **The staff had saved the bear once. Years later, it seemed to know exactly where to bring someone else.**
